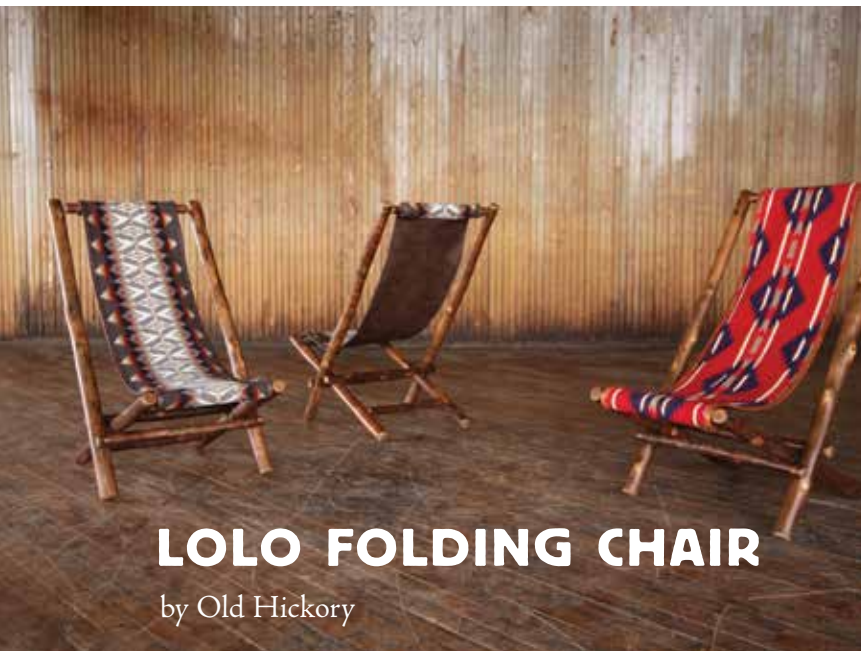
LEATHER DOCTOR'S BAG

Blair stains the background and applies an antique finish and wax before hand-rubbing it to create a European-style finish.
